

A Report on the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) (2019-2020)

Our college made a survey on year-long teaching learning process, the facilities available in the college (both physical and intellectual) and overall infrastructure among the final year students of each department (both Honours and General). The senior members of IQAC made a specific questionnaire covering all aspects. This survey was done online using the google forms.

We circulated the forms among around 250 students.

- 93% of them ensured us that they are satisfied with the overall teaching-learning process.
- The students complained that only 65% teachers use LCD projectors and ICT tools while teaching.
- Although the syllabus is vast enough, 95% students informed that the syllabus has been completed thoroughly in time.
- Each student is satisfied with the fair examination process.
- 94% students are happy to explore themselves in view of extra-curricular activities.
- 89% students said that they are pleased with the efforts given by the teachers to introduce them to the world of work, whereas 11% says the effort is moderate, not enough.
- 65% students are happy with the library facilities but rest of them emphasizes on upgradation.
- 52% students are satisfied with the canteen and common room facilities whereas the rest of the students complained on this point.
- Each student joyfully certified that our college has a ragging-free and sexual-harassment free campus.

In view of the scenario, IQAC planned about the upgradation of the library, college canteen and washroom. The committee also requested the teachers to be more involved in using ICT tools and projectors while taking the classes. Team IQAC also provided the students a mail id where they could send their suggestions freely. The mail id is-iqacumm@gmail.com.
